



## **Important Notice**

If you are a parent with HUSKY A (Medicaid) health insurance and your annual income is more than \$24,831 per year for a family of 2, or \$31,248 for a family of three, or \$37,665 for a family of four, you are going to lose your health insurance from HUSKY A on July 31, 2016 of this year. Your children will still have insurance – **but you will not!**

## **What should you do?**

1. Contact the Caring Families Coalition (CFC) so that we can help you figure out what you can do. You can reach CFC by calling Yomaira Colon at 860-524-0502 or send a message to her at yomaira.colon @ucanct.org.
2. If you have access to the internet:
  - Go to [learn.accesshealthct.com/husky-move](http://learn.accesshealthct.com/husky-move). This site contains lots of information on what is happening and why.
  - Go to the AccessHealthCT website [accesshealthct.com](http://accesshealthct.com). If you already have an account with Access Health, log in and click “Make a Change” to begin. Once you have updated your information, click on “Enroll now”, and fill in your information in the areas provided. You may be eligible for a subsidy to help you pay for an insurance policy through AccessHealthCT.
3. If you want to do this by phone, call Access Health at 1-855-371-2428.
4. If you don’t want to use the internet or the phone, you can fill out the paper form that came with your letter from DSS and mail it in.
5. Attend one of the free in-person help that Access Health will schedule. There will be professional insurance brokers there who can help you decide the best insurance for you. Access Health can be contacted by calling 1-855-371-2428.

## **Will you be losing your Medicaid coverage on July 31, 2016?**

You may qualify for other types of HUSKY Health if:

- Your income has gone down
- Your household size has increased
- You are pregnant
- You have breast or cervical cancer or tuberculosis
- You are blind or disabled
- You recently turned 65
- You have very high medical bills that qualify you for coverage (called “spend down”)
- You need family planning services. HUSKY has a coverage group for men and women who need family planning services, such as birth control
