

HELP PROTECT YOUR HEALTH CARE

CONGRESS IS WORKING TO REPEAL THE AFFORDABLE CARE ACT (OBAMACARE) AND PASS A NEW HEALTH CARE BILL.

WHAT WILL THIS NEW BILL MEAN FOR CONNECTICUT?

- **Medicaid/HUSKY Health will be cut.** Over 74,400 adults and 31,400 children stand to lose their Husky coverage.
- **Insurers can cover less *and* charge you more money.** Insurers would no longer be required to cover important health benefits, such as mental health and maternity care. They could also charge you more for health issues such as asthma, allergies and diabetes.
- **You will get less help to pay for your health care.** The Republican bill would cut financial help on AccessHealthCT.
- **Seniors will be charged more.** If the bill passes the senate, a 60 year-old earning \$30,000 in Hartford would pay over \$12,000/yr in health care insurance premiums.

WHAT CAN I DO TO PROTECT MY HEALTH CARE?

Call your U.S. Senators and tell them why Medicaid/HUSKY Health is important to you.

Call your senators and **share why health care matters to you.** Tell them they need to **defend the Affordable Care Act** from attacks that will cut Medicaid and take away coverage from 23 million people.
